### ITINERARY

- Day 1: **Barcelona** ~ Hotel check-in. Check into your Barcelona hotel for the beginning of your Colors of Provence pre-cruise land program.
- Day 2: **Barcelona** ~ "The Best of Barcelona" tour. Barcelona, the bustling capital of Catalonia. Tour the cobblestoned lanes of the Gothic Quarter in the medieval city center and Las Ramblas. See imaginative architectural creations, highlights of the UNESCO World Heritage Site "Works of Antoni Gaudi." (B)


- Day 3: **Barcelona** ~ "The Mountains and Abbey of Montserrat" excursion. Home to the Benedictine monastery of Santa Maria de Montserrat, you'll ride a scenic funicular to the top of the mountain and experience an indescribable view of the Catalonia landscape. While here, you'll see the famous Black Madonna sculpture and the stairway leading to the statue, plus the room and altar in which the statue sits are ornate, golden and pay tribute to the wonder that is the Virgin herself. (B)
- Day 4: **Barcelona** ~ Hotel check-out. High-speed train to Nîmes and then transfer to Avignon. This is **EMBARKATION DAY** for your cruise. (B,D)
- Day 5: **Tarascon** ~ Evening cruise to illuminated Pont d'Avignon. Tarascon is known for its medieval architecture and charming tales. Join a guided walking tour to visit the Roman ruins of Arles: Roman Amphitheater and the Church of Saint Trophime. Alternatively, you can enjoy a bike ride along the Rhône, through town to the Langlois Bridge, a famous subject from several Vincent Van Gogh paintings. Join a special walking tour along with a visit to the Vincent van Gogh Foundation, showcasing his legacy. During the afternoon, visit the enchanting medieval fortress, the Castle of Tarascon or venture to the medieval hilltop village, Les Baux de Provence and then delve deeply into the Carrières de Lumières. (B,L,D)
- Day 6: **Avignon** ~ Named the "City of Popes," Avignon was the center of the Catholic Church in the 14th century when its "Palais des Papes" was the equivalent

of today's Vatican. Discover the history of Avignon on a guided walking tour that includes the Papal Palace and the well-preserved medieval walls surrounding the historic center of town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Or, visit three venues around Avignon to taste regional specialties including macarons, cheese and wine, and tapenades. You can go to another UNESCO World Heritage Site, the impressive Pont du Gard, a Roman aqueduct that is a masterpiece of ancient engineering. (B,L,D)

- Day 7: **Viviers** ~ Take in the quaint surroundings of Viviers, a charming commune that sidles up to the right bank of the Rhone. From Viviers, travel to the magnificent hilltop village, Grignan. After visiting this enchanting Provençal town, go in search of the highly prized "Black Diamond" truffles with a farmer and his canine companion. (B,L,D)
- Day 8: **Tournon** ~ Admire the hilltop village of Tournon with its imposing castle. Take an exclusive private train ride past magnificent landscape carved along the Gorge du Doux, stopping at the charming station of Colombier le Vieux-Saint Barthélemy le Plain. Or, lovers of wine and chocolate will want to visit Le Château de Tournon for a presentation and tasting on the pairing of red wine and



chocolate. Or, hike through the vineyards of Tain l'Hermitage, followed by a visit to a local winery. (B,L,D)

- Day 9: **Vienne** ~ Between the wine regions of Beaujolais and Côtes du Rhône, follow the footsteps of the ancient Romans on a walking tour to see the well-preserved Augustus and Livia Temple, the Saint Maurice Cathedral, and St. Pierre Abbey—one of the oldest surviving churches in France. Or, take a guided hike from the ship to the Monastery at Mount Pipet or a guided bike tour along a portion of the ViaRhôna bike route. We'll travel to Lyon, considered the "Food Capital of France" and enjoy a walking tour that is home to the 19th-century basilica Notre-Dame de Fourvière. You can also visit the famous indoor market hall Les Halles de Lyon – Paul Bocuse. Sample of the delicacies offered by butchers, bakers, chocolatiers & cheesemongers. (B,L,D)
- Day 10: **Villefranche-sur-Saone** ~ Beaujolais excursion and tasting. Visit a traditional Beaujolais winery and learn the history and techniques of their vineyard. Plus, enjoy a tasting of their specialty. (B,L,D)
- Day 11: **Lyon** ~ DISEMBARKATION
